Students will be required to complete the following:

1. Complete all the activities and pages of the Mental Health Workbook. This will be worth a test grade by the ending of the 1st quarter, October 8th. All students should get a good head start over the summer (and possibly even finish the workbook), as they will have regular homework assignments every night, Monday - Thursday, once school begins in August.

These Vision Boards will be displayed in students' homeroom classes as a visual reminder of their long-term goals.

3. Read through and complete the exercises in the Grammar Workbook for practice. Students will take a test on ALL the skills featured in the Grammar Workbook on the 3rd week of school, Monday, August 31st.
